

# PROSECCO

**Prosecco is made from Glera grapes in north-east Italy where the climate is temperate, with cold, wet winters and hot, dry summers.**

The two delimited regions are Prosecco DOC, covering a wide area of the Veneto and Friuli, and the higher-quality DOCG, located between the two Venetian towns, Conegliano and Valdobbiadene.

Typically produced by the tank method, Proseccos have medium acidity with fresh aromas of green apple and melon. Though similarly sorted into Brut, Extra Dry and Dry styles, they are slightly higher in residual sugar than Champagne, and are best consumed young and fresh.

The UK is the largest consumer of Prosecco outside its native country; it has become a cultural staple for Brits. A recent change to official rules allowing the production of Prosecco DOC Rosé (a combination of Glera and Pinot Noir), together with Britain's love of fizz and an ever-growing trend towards anything pink, has provided a perfect platform for the much-longed-for Pink Prosecco.

**The northern most wine producing region in France, Champagne produces sparkling wines of exceptional quality and heritage which are sought after around the world.**

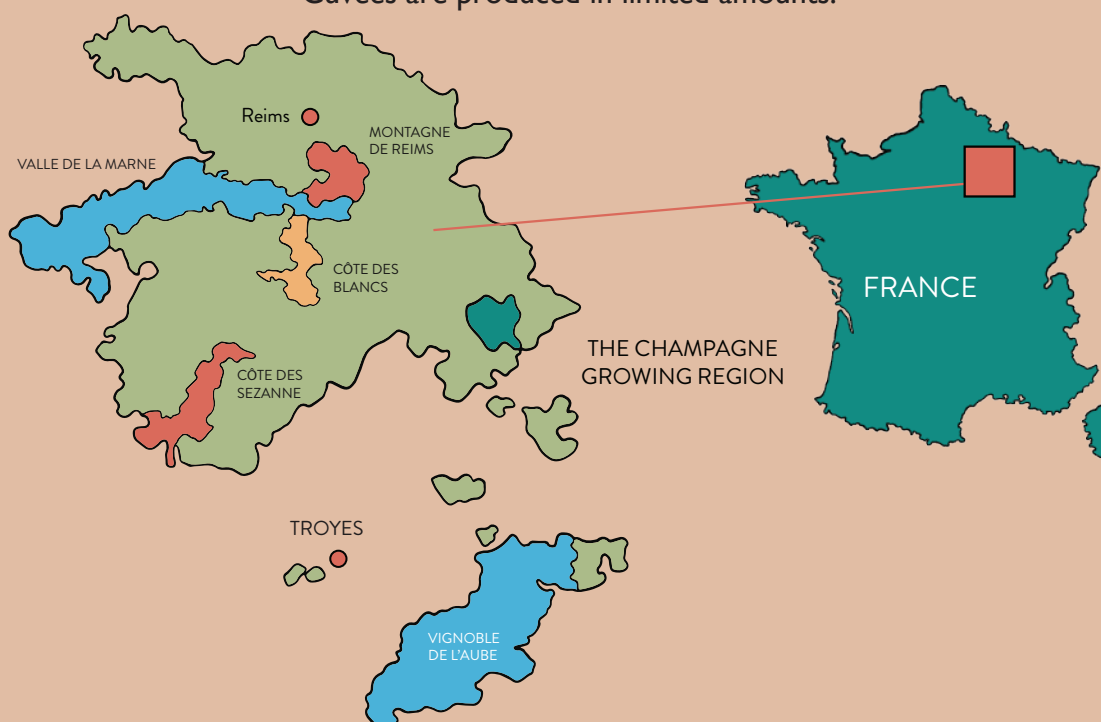
The wines are produced by the méthode champenoise, a traditional and complex practice of fermenting wine a second time in the bottle which results a characteristically fine mousse (bubbles).

Strict and comprehensive appellation guidelines regulate almost every aspect of how Champagne is produced, leading to wines of a very consistent style and quality.

Whilst the Champagne market in the UK is dominated by large, recognisable brands (grand marques), there are also many smaller producers and co-operatives that produce excellent wines whilst still offering great value for money for you and your customers. LWC works closely with smaller producers to bring new, exciting Champagnes into the UK whilst maintaining strong relationships with large producers to ensure we continue to secure strong pricing and large allocations for our customers.

Most Champagne sold in the UK is non-vintage (N/V), where winemakers carefully blend wines produced with grapes from several harvests to ensure that wines remain consistent year to year. In years where the quality is exceptional houses may produce vintage Champagne, where all the grapes come from the same year's harvest.

Many houses then produce a prestige cuvée – a top wine made from their very best grapes and often aged for very extended periods. Vintage Champagnes and Prestige Cuvées are produced in limited amounts.

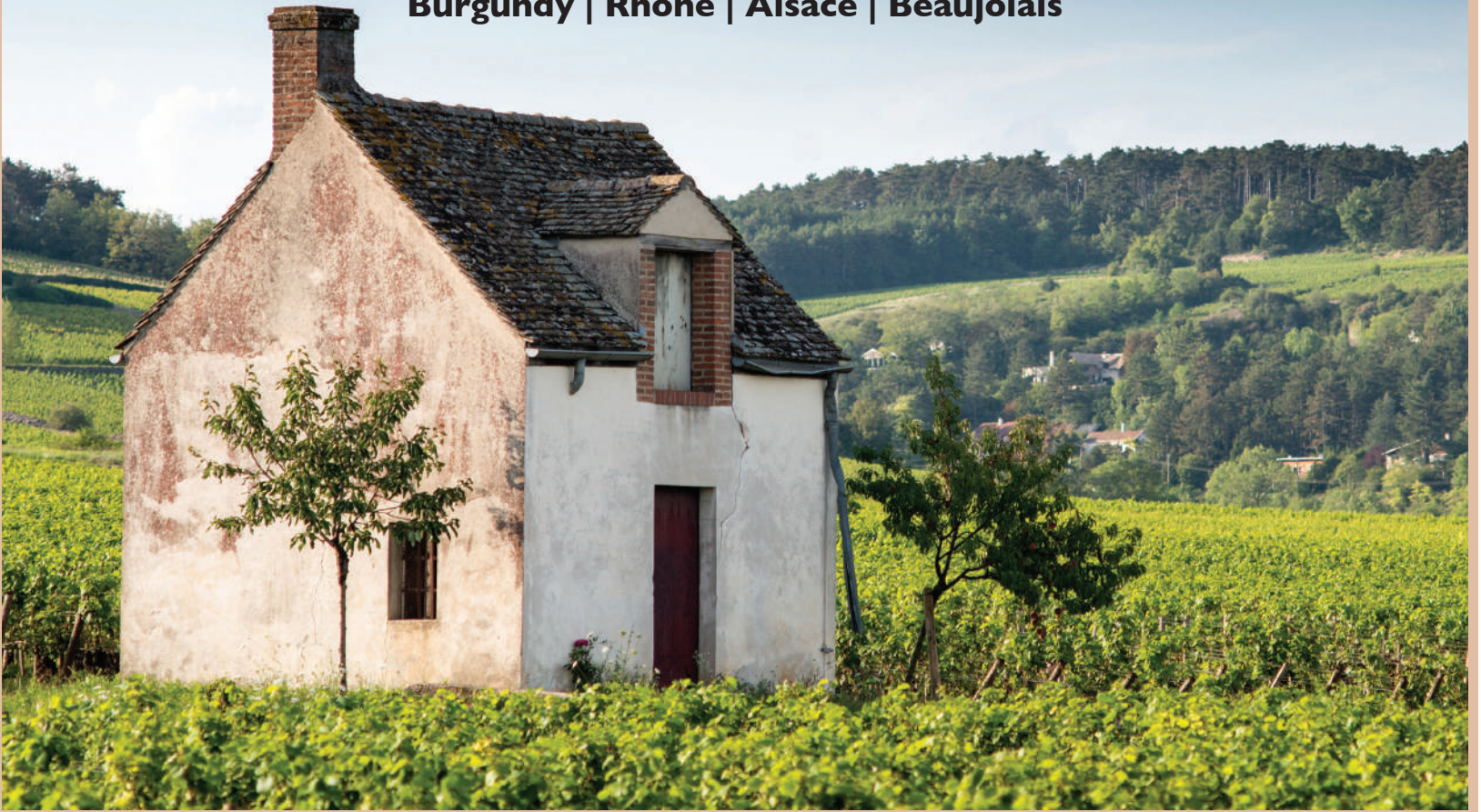

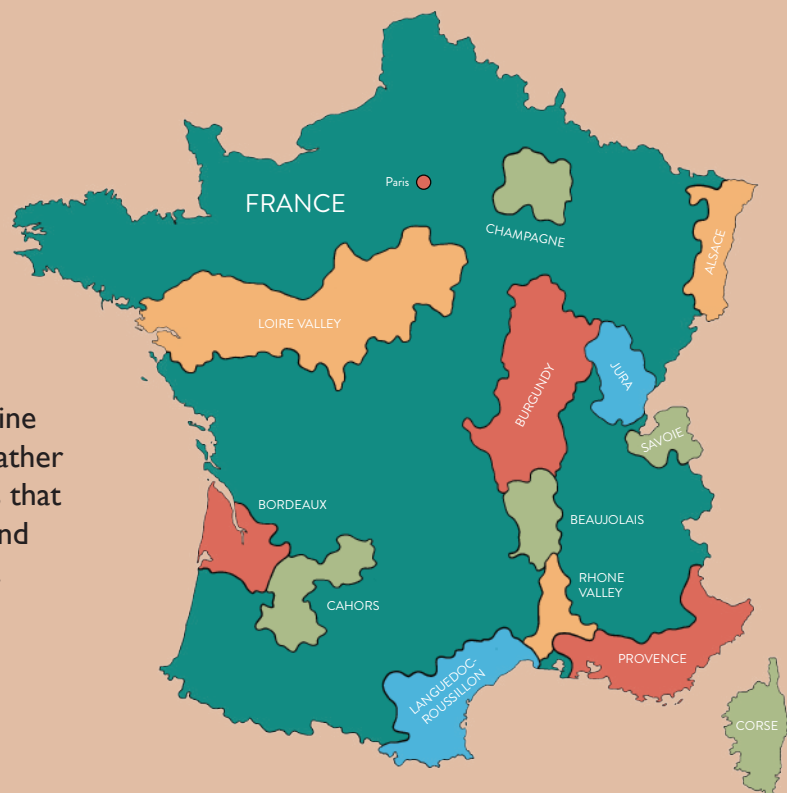

‘Vin de France’ is the term for table wine from France; it indicates grape variety, rather than being labelled by region. This means that the wines are typically sold under brand names or as branded varietal wines.

# IBERIA PENINSULA

**Spain has a long history of wine production; styles vary from traditional oak-aged reds to modern, fruity whites. International grape varieties have been planted in many of Spain's wine regions, but it is the country's indigenous varieties such as Albariño, Godello and Monastrell that are increasingly celebrated.**

IBERIA IS PRINCIPALLY DIVIDED BETWEEN SPAIN AND PORTUGAL. Portugal is believed to be one of the first wine-producing regions in the world. Spain is the most planted area; more than half of all wines fall into the quality classification D.O. Only 2 have the prestigious D.O.Ca. and D.O.Q. – Rioja and Priorat.

# ITALY

**Italy provides us with some of the oldest wine regions in the world. It contains 20 wine regions with over 350 grape varieties. The Italian classification system was first launched 1963 and has 3 basic categories.**

I.G.T. Wines (PGI Protected Geographical Indication) This category is for wines produced in a specific territory within Italy and in line with the specific regulations.

p.d.o. – D.O.C. (Controlled Designation of Origin) – These wines generally come from smaller regions, and are particularly well known for their quality and history; they have more strict regulations for production, and must have been an I.G.T. for a minimum of 5 years.

p.d.o. – D.O.C.G. – A D.O.C. wine can be promoted to a D.O.C.G. if it has been a D.O.C. for at least 10 years. They are subject to extremely strict regulations and approved by committee.

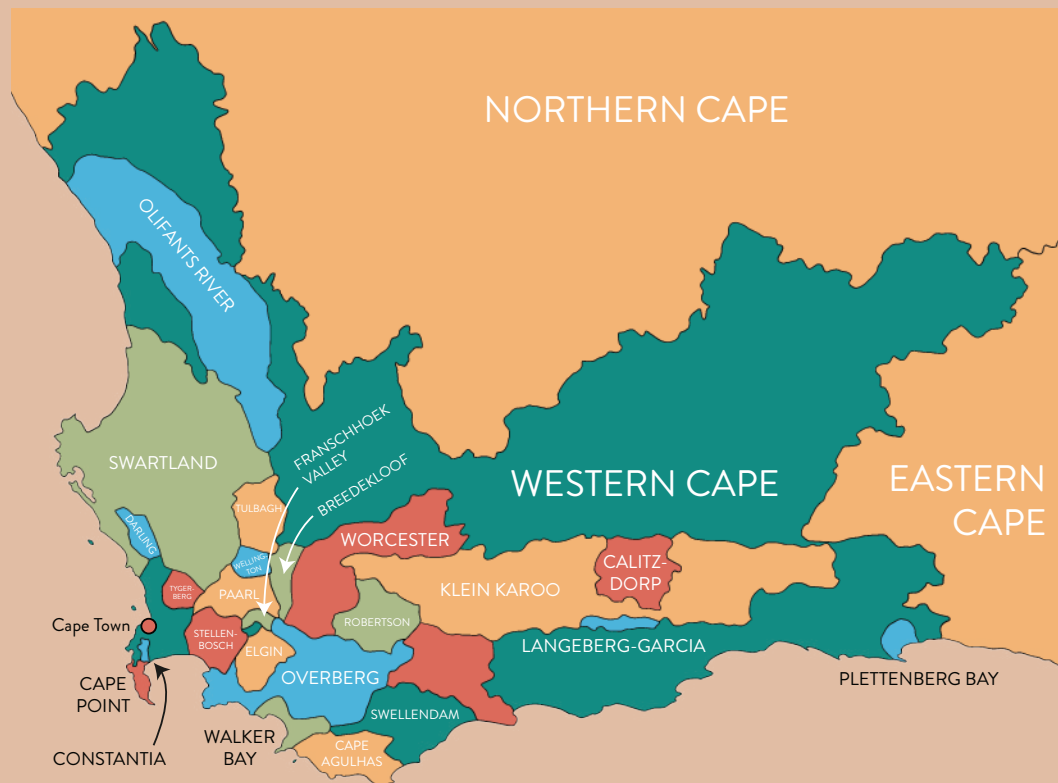
